The Day Camp program is for children going into grades 1-6. While these campers only stay for the day, the schedule is packed with games, crafts, camp activities, meals, and Bible studies.

Adventure Camp is an outdoor experiential learning program designed for a smaller number of campers. The campsite is located on the camp property, but they travel and experience a wide variety of outdoor challenges.

Because the safety and concern for your child is our number one priority, New Life hires quality counselors and trains them to lead your child well. A week of camp has the promise to be a very important time in the *spiritual life of your child*.

(Residential Camp)

The Camp Kainos environment revolves around the Main Lodge and campers will reside in small cabin groups with trained and caring counselors. The weekly program is designed for each age group; elementary, junior high and high school, and allows for age appropriate activities that meet the needs of your camper's age. Registration Notes:

Activity Fee: There are several "extra" activity options this summer. Some weeks of Camp Kainos offer special activities for your child to choose. The extra options include horses and mountain bike riding. These activities are \$10. The options that are available for each week will be seen during the registration process. There is an option for teens registering for Teen Week (Grades 10-12) of Camp Kainos who wish to go on a Whitewater rafting trip on the Youghiogheny River. There is an additional \$65 fee for the first 20 registrations.

Camp Fee: A \$25 non-refundable registration deposit is required for EACH week registered. This deposit is included in the camp fee.

Discounts: There are various discounts available to help make camp more affordable. Please note that only one discount can be applied to your camp fee per applicant.

Early Bird Discount: This discount is available to those who register by March 1st. The discount will be based on the program that the camper attends.

- **Day Camp** \$5 Discount
- **Camp Kainos** \$10 Discount
- **Adventure Camp** \$15 Discount

3rd Child Discount: If your child is the third child from the same family coming to camp, please pay only 50% of the camp fee for that child. Same discount applies to each additional child.

Full-Time Ministry Worker Discount: This discount is 25% of the total camp fee.

Online Registration:

Go to our website to register for your week(s) of camp. Create an account or if you are a returning user, enter your credentials to speed up the registration process by saving your information from year to year. Simply enter the information online and submit your registration. You will receive an email statement showing your balance, along with links to download a parent's guide (which provides important information), and a packing list. Our site also allows you to return for payments and to view information regarding your child's week of camp. If you need a paper registration, please contact the camp to have one sent to you.

Refund Policy: In the event of an injury or sickness, we will refund the full amount of payment (minus the \$25 registration deposit) if the cancellation is made up to one day prior to arrival at camp. During camp, the refund will be prorated for the amount of days not present. Refunds are not given for homesickness.

Snack/Gift Shop Deposit: You may include a deposit into your child's snack account online at our website. Early deposit of snack money will enable you to check-in more quickly.

Scholarships:

New Life is pleased to provide scholarship assistance for campers who qualify. Scholarships are available through the Ed & Peg Donaldson Memorial Fund. New Life Bible Camp seeks to distribute these funds with fairness and discernment. More information on requesting a scholarship is online. Scholarships are only available for one week of camp. If you would like to register your child for two weeks and need financial assistance, we ask that you pay for the first week and apply for a scholarship for the second week of camp.

Weekend Fee: A \$45 fee will be added for campers who need to stay on the weekends. The weekends are not a part of our summer camp program and are to be used for the convenience of the parent(s)/guardian(s) due to transportation, schedule conflicts, and children who are different ages coming to weeks following each other. Please notify the camp to request a weekend application. Limited spaces available.

At the end of each week we close with a special program to highlight the week for parents and guests. This program begins after the camper's last dinner on Friday at 6:00 pm. All are welcome to attend. Checkout of campers follows this program.

Arrival and Check-in Time Change! Check-in will be at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday of each week of camp for Kainos and Adventure Camp (Except the week of July 10-12). Day Campers will check in on Monday of each week, no earlier than 9:00 a.m.
